The T-Series includes Fluorescent Highbay Lighting with T5HO and T8 lamps.

The new T5 High Output Fluorescent and T8 Fluorescent Luminaires are made for indoor highbay and lowbay applications, such as athletic facilities, commercial, retail or industrial spaces where a linear light source is optimal. These fixtures can be suspended individually or in continuous rows. Their beam spreads can be wide for open areas, or narrow, for aisles.

The energy-efficiency of the T-Series starts with its design. T-Series fixtures can come with reflectors of up to 95 percent enhanced specular aluminum, which gives maximum light on the floor, while expending no more energy than is necessary. The reflectors are shipped with a protective covering which is removed during installation for a clean, blemish-free appearance. Another optical option is a 92 percent high performance reflector made with white painted aluminum.

Energy savings can be enhanced with accessories such as motion sensors, which go on or off depending on a room's occupants, or through the use of multi-level switching or dimming ballasts.

In addition, each product in the T-Series of fluorescent highbay lighting with T5HO and T8 lamps has advanced, high-efficiency electronic technology, which offers considerable savings when compared with older technology.

The TE-Series™ includes a lighter weight option, constructed with cold rolled steel, which helps reduce its cost. Still it maintains the lamp performance common to all of the T-Series: the white light of T5 high output or T8 fluorescent lamps combine superior lumen maintenance and excellent color rendering with a high CRI.

The TC-Series™ offers the same superior lamp performance and energy efficiency, with more cost-effectiveness in a smaller unit. It has two-, three-, and four-lamp options while the T-Series and TE-Series come with four or six lamps.

All fixtures in the T-Series can come with upright slots, allowing for the appeal of well-lit ceilings. Lenses can also be prismatic acrylic or polycarbonate. Any product in the T-Series can feature instant start ballasts for applications where lights need to come on quickly; or programmed start ballasts, for more frequent on-and-off switching, useful when used with an energy-efficient motion sensor.
