**NEW THIS SEASON: DESIGN-FORWARD HALOGEN TRACK LIGHTING**  
*Juno's new stylish configurations combine with technological innovations*

**DES PLAINES, III. (Nov. 11, 2007)** — New additions to Juno's family of halogen trac lighting products put design forward, while maintaining the excellence in engineering for which Juno Lighting Group™ is known.

These innovative new trac fixture designs emphasize the creative aesthetics that have come to be expected from Juno.

"We were seeking to make a design statement and re-affirm Juno as the trac lighting style leader," said Michael McCown, Director of Product Management for Trac Lighting.

The design team tapped into their creative wells to come up with new fixtures, inspired by forms found in aviation, architecture and the natural world.

"We wanted to say 'we're always evolving,'" said Juno's Senior Industrial Designer Bruce Layne. "We wanted to step forward."

Juno's engineering teams met the challenge of creating the cutting-edge designs with totally concealed wiring, which required innovations in die-casting and hinge mechanics. A unique new trac adapter was also developed for the line-voltage versions, which complements the stylish new fixture designs.

The new trendsetters in halogen trac lighting fixtures are as follows:

**Cubix™** – The most playful of the bunch, Cubix combines two different geometric forms, the cube and the ring. In this design, the stem becomes the central element, forming a pleasing visual extension of the cube form.

**Xanadu™** – This fixture presents the most striking and minimal form, a pure shape devoid of any extraneous detail. Xanadu aims for sleek, streamlined, classic beauty.

**Glacis™** – The flower-like Glacis reflects the beauty of the natural world. It has a truncated conical element at the top that cloaks the stem pivot when viewed from the conventional viewing angles.

**Facet™** – The Facet has a more asymmetrical and artistic aesthetic than the others, with a socket housing that morphs into a stem completely horizontal in nature. Its bold simplicity gives it an ultra-clean appearance.

**Mamba™** – An original, daring design with a front-loading gimbal ring, the Mamba combines gracefully curved and tapered elements to produce a unique and totally unexpected result.

All of the new halogen trac fixtures are constructed of die-cast aluminum and are offered in black, white and silver finishes. Each fixture can be rotated 360 degrees and vertically aimed up to approximately 105 degrees to eliminate aiming dead spots. Designed for versatility of application, all are suitable for retail, hospitality, residential and commercial applications.

For line voltage assignments, there are versions compatible with PAR20, PAR30, or PAR38 halogen lamps. For low-voltage assignments, there are versions compatible with the versatile MR16 halogen lamp. Each of the designs is available for use with Juno Trac-Master, Trac 12 and Flex 12 trac systems.
